#### -Executive Session-

Ablen from Delaware Engineering spoke briefly regarding the WWTP. He stated that bids were just opened regarding removal of compacted sludge. They will go back to their office and go over the bids and let the town know before next Wednesday.

Steve Hart update on Regeneron Pedestrian Bridge, they are still trying to work out all the aspects of the project, Steve is hoping that all will be ready in two to three weeks for presentation to the planning board. The bridge is glass and is not a conditioned space, it is 94 feet long and 17feet high.

Steve Hart gave an update on the Witbeck PDD project on Phillips Road. Steve stated that they have downsized the project from 100 units to 90. He stated that this project started back in 2011 and came to a halt due to DEC not letting any other connections. He also stated these will all be owner occupied.

Richard Dewey from NYSIO spoke regarding the resolution asking for the supervisor to sign a certain contribution agreement with the Town and NYSIO for paving of Krey Blvd. They are offering the Town \$125,000 toward the paving, it is a Town road. Councilperson Matters wants the language changed before the next meeting and wants to see a copy prior to that.

Mary Ann also inquired as to who was doing the paving, Dan Fiacco stated that he has already sent the project out to bid and there are three reputable business.

Deputy Supervisor Meaghan Hart made a motion to move to executive session to discuss litigation and a personnel matter. Councilperson DiMartino seconded resulting in a vote as follows:
