



### East Greenbush Facts Transportation

#### Vehicular Mobility

The Town of East Greenbush developed along the Columbia Turnpike, which served as the main highway between Albany and Boston, prior to the construction of I-90.

Several key transportation corridors travel through the Town of East Greenbush, including:

- > Interstate 90
- > Route 4
- > Route 9/20 (Columbia Turnpike)

Columbia Turnpike remains one of the most heavily traveled transportation corridors in the Capital Region with an average annual daily traffic count of 26,999 vehicles.

#### Public Transit

Public transportation is limited in East Greenbush; however, bus service is provided by the Capital District Transportation Authority (CDTA) in several locations. Bus routes include:

- > Route 520: Travels from Schodack Park and Ride to Empire State Plaza. No direct stops in East Greenbush
- > Route 233: Travels from downtown Albany to the Schodack Park and Ride with a number of stops along Columbia Turnpike in East Greenbush

#### Bicycle and Pedestrian Mobility

Bicycle and pedestrian mobility in East Greenbush is limited; however, the construction of the Albany-Hudson Electric Trail will create a number of opportunities for improved access and mobility.



### PROJECT UPDATE

#### **Public Open House #2**

On Monday, September 30, 2019 the Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee (CPSC)

held its second public workshop. The event was held from 6:00-8:00 PM at the Red Barn in the East Greenbush Town Park. Over 70 residents, property owners, business owners, and other stakeholders participated in the event.

The workshop included a presentation followed by topic-based speedround discussions where attendees cycled through five stations for ten minutes each to discuss needs and opportunities about particular topic areas. Stations included Transportation and Mobility, Economic Growth, Neighborhoods and Housing, Recreation, Agriculture and Natural Resources and Governance and Infrastructure.
