Target store workers called police after they saw Jeffrey M. Jackson, 52 of Albany in the process of shoplifting a set of home security systems worth \$375.00. He was charged with Larceny by Officer Raymond Diaz.

In other cases;

Brett M. Koon, 32 of East Greenbush was taken into custody for Larceny and Resisting Arrest after being chased on foot for several minutes by Officer Michael Herrington. Store workers noticed Koon briskly leaving Walmart without paying for a cartful of merchandise he had selected, including; 2 men's electric razors, hand sanitizer, a children's shopkins set, shopkins karaoke set, make up wipes, acne wash, Faber ware, 3 liter fryer, men's deodorant, shaving cream, a heavy duty plug and a Christmas Greeting Card, worth a total of \$375.00.

Anthony L. Angelo, 31 of East Greenbush was taken into custody by Detective Michael Guadagnino on a Town Court Bench Warrant for failing to show up in a pending criminal case. At the time arrested, he was found in possession of a pair of Hypodermic needles and was charged with Criminal Possession of a Hypodermic Instrument.

Joshua L. Bombard, 35 of East Nassau was clocked travelling 57 MPH in the 35 MPH zone of Columbia Turnpike and was stopped for speeding by Officer Trevor LaGrave. Police documented evidence of alcohol impairment, and Bombard was taken into custody for DWI. He was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engle and, due to already having a revoked license and several local prior DWI offenses, he was remanded to County Jail.
