Brett A. Seibert, 29 of Selkirk was arrested Wednesday afternoon January 3rd, after he used a stolen credit to make purchases at Home Depot on Troy Road.

The case began a few minutes earlier, when a local woman reported that her pocketbook had just been stolen from her shopping cart at Walmart. Officer Michael Herrington arrived to investigate and the victim proceeded to notify her bank and credit accounts that her ID and cards were stolen.

However, within minutes, the victim received an alert that her bank card was being used at the nearby Home Depot store. Officer Herrington responded from Walmart to Home Depot and began to inspect the checkouts at which time Seibert saw the officer and bolted from the store. He was chased on foot through the parking lot where he was taken into custody. The stolen bank cards were found in his possession.

Seibert was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engel on charges of Grand Larceny 4th Dgr., Larceny, Resisting Arrest and Possession of a Hypodermic Instrument, and was remanded to County Jail.
