Police are investigating a case of domestic violence which included a police pursuit.

At about 8:06 this morning, a female called 911 to say that her ex-boyfriend was stalking her and following her in his car as she was driving South on Vandenburg Avenue , US Rte. 4 (Troy Road).

As the woman proceeded to drive in a southerly direction, the ex-boyfriend, now identified as Jonathan E. Volland, 34 of Cohoes, began to ram his car into hers. State Police, Troy Police, North Greenbush and East Greenbush Police were notified of the ongoing active assault.

At one point, the female caller was caught up in traffic behind a Rte. 4 traffic signal. Volland used this opportunity to get out of his car to run up to the victim where he tried to open her car doors then tried to break a window. But as traffic started to move again, the victim got away.

Police encountered the suspect vehicle on Rte. 4 and attempted to make a traffic stop. Volland refused to comply and would not stop and proceeded to lead police on a chase, South on Rte. 4, onto Columbia Turnpike to Gilligan Road, to Hays Road where it was terminated involving a collision with a police cruiser. Volland was taken into custody by Officer Nicholas Peter and State Troopers.

He was arraigned this afternoon before Town Justice George J. Hoffman Jr. on charges of Reckless Endangerment 1st Dgr., Reckless Endangerment 2nd Dgr. and Unlawfully Fleeing a Police Officer. He was remanded to County Jail pending further court proceedings.
