In other cases;

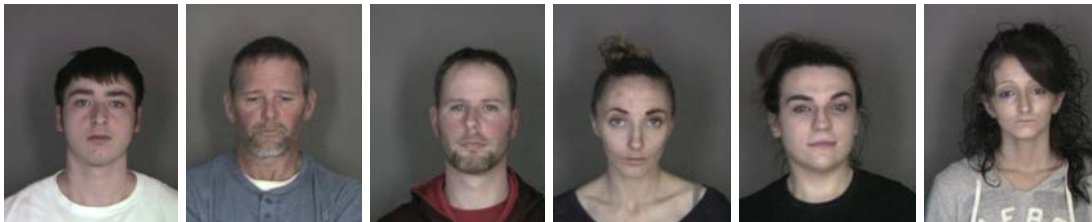
