The charges were drawn by Detective Michael Guadagnino following a "check the welfare" investigation last month that located Reis in a stressed state of mind, armed with a rifle, the unlawful ammunition clip and hypodermic syringe paraphernalia.

Shawn M. Riley, 34 of East Greenbush was charged by Detective Michael Guadagnino with Aggravated Harassment 2nd Dr. An acquaintance claimed that Riley had threatened him with bodily harm through Facebook.

Pauline R. Bessette, 54 of Troy was arrested by Officer Donald Deitz for leaving the Target store with a microwave and an electric coffee pot in her shopping cart that she had not paid for. The merchandise was worth \$140.00.
