In other cases;

Shantelle M. Jordan Byrd, 26 of Troy was charged by Officer Michael Herrington with Larceny, after Byrd fraudulently claimed a "refund" for the "return" of brand new Walmart merchandise that she had simply lifted off a store rack and brought to the customer service desk.

Zachary T. Zerniak, 31 of East Greenbush was charged with Obstructing Governmental Administration 2nd Dgr. after he interfered with the investigation of a domestic dispute that he was involved in. He was taken into custody by Officer Edward Witko. Zerniak was arraigned before Town Justice Mary Pat Donnelly on additional charges of Resisting Arrest and remanded to County Jail.

Richard F. Campbell, 39 of Troy was arrested for Larceny by Officer Raymond Diaz after Campbell wheeled four full size Firestone tires worth \$500.00, out of the Walmart automotive section without paying.

Kiazhaire S. Banks, 18 of Albany was charged with Larceny by Officer Warren Kretzschmar, who had been summoned by Walmart to investigate fraudulent misuse of store credit transactions.
