Ryleigh E. DiDonna, 20 of Glens Falls, was arrested by Officer Nicholas Peter, after she smashed a liquor bottle into the face of another woman during a confrontation in the street on Vermont Avenue. DiDonna was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engel on charges of Assault 2<sup>nd</sup> Dgr. and Criminal Possession of a Weapon 4<sup>th</sup> Dgr. and was remanded to Probation house arrest with day reporting pending further court proceedings.

In other cases;

Billy W. Williamson, 64 of Rensselaer was arrested for shoplifting 5 steaks and a pound of bacon, worth \$85.00 from the Walmart grocery section. He was charged with Larceny by Officer Peter Partak.

At 8:30 a.m., neighbors called police to report seeing a 10 year old child, wearing only pajamas, walking down the street in sub-freezing temperature. Officer Warren Kretzschmar responded and located the child, who said she had walked away from home due to an argument. Police proceeded to the child's residence, where they encountered Hermann E. Kouamelan, 31 and Laura O. Kamara, the child's parents/guardians. As police attempted to investigate the circumstances of the wandering child, both guardians engaged in belligerent hostility to the officers and refused to provide identification or information about themselves. Before long, both were taken into custody; charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Obstructing Government Administration 2<sup>nd</sup> Dgr., Resisting Arrest and other counts.
