At 2:30 a.m. Saturday morning, three Albany women and a Troy teenager entered Walmart and swarmed the store, splitting up and quickly filling shopping carts with merchandise. Store workers contacted police when the four culprits rushed past checkouts and loaded the goods into a vehicle and took off. As Officer Edward Ashley was responding, he observed the suspect vehicle on Troy Road and conducted a vehicle stop. Taken into custody was Janira D. McCall, 17, Stephanie D. Blair, 35, Ketia J. Louis, 36 and a 15 year old female. One thousand dollars worth of stolen merchandise was recovered from the vehicle.
