130-2024 A Resolution Authorizing the Use of GEIS Water/Sewer Fees and Water Fund for the Upgrades to the Cross Street Pump Station

Schedule of Meeting / Presentations: Honoring Columbia High School Sports Teams

WHEREAS, the Town Board approved the Contracts for upgrades to the Cross Street Pump Station in Resolution 80-2024; and

WHEREAS the contracts were awarded as follows:

Contract #1 – General Construction – Trinity Construction of Selkirk, NY \$1,398,573.00;

Contract #2 – Electrical Construction – O'Connell Electric of Schenectady, NY - \$1,164,897.00;

Contract #3 – HVAC Construction – Kipper Plumbing & Heating of Halfmoon, NY - \$33,250.00;

Total contract amounts equal \$2,596,720.00; and

WHEREAS, in the GEIS Committee Meeting held on May 13th, 2024, the Commissioner of Public Works presented this information to the GEIS Committee who voted to recommend approval of the use of GEIS funds for partial funding for the upgrades at the Cross Street Pump Station; and

WHEREAS, Water Fund will need to be used for the remaining balance of the project; and

WHEREAS, the costs for this stage of the project are to be split with the City of Rensselaer at 50% each as the original Inter-Municipal Agreement between the Town and City states that the cost of Capital Projects shall be divided equally between the two municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of East Greenbush will be the Project Manager for this project and will provide regular updates and monthly invoices to the City of Rensselaer for the cost of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance confirms this project will have a material impact on the Town and will be funded from the GEIS and Water Fund balances and these approved funds will be transferred to a capital project to be set up for proper tracking of expenses and reimbursement from the City of Rensselaer;

now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby approve the use of \$650,000.00 from the Water/Sewer GEIS accounts and \$650,000.00 from the Water Fund Balance to fund East Greenbush's portion of the Cross Street Pump Station Upgrade Project.

A Resolution to Award the Bid for Upgrades to the Wastewater Treatment Plant and Approve the Use of GEIS Water Sewer Fees and Sewer Fund Balance for the Project

WHEREAS, the Town Board authorized the Commissioner of Public Works to work with Adirondack Mountain Engineering (AME) regarding the need for upgrades at the Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) in Resolution 254-2023; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board authorized the solicitation of Bids for upgrades to the Wastewater Treatment Plant in Resolution 32-2024; and

WHEREAS, bids were solicited and opened on Thursday, April 25, 2024, and upon review by the Town Designated Engineer, Adirondack Mountain Engineering, the recommendation to award was made to the lowest responsible bidder: Contract #1 – General Const. – J. Squared Construction of Voorheesville, NY - \$1,062,000; and

WHEREAS, the low bid is in conformance with the project bid requirements; and WHEREAS, the Director of Finance confirms this project will have a material impact on the Town to be funded from GEIS and Sewer Fund balances and these approved funds will be transferred to a capital project for proper tracking and expenses; and

WHEREAS, in the GEIS Committee Meeting held on May 13th, 2024, the Commissioner of Public Works presented this information to the GEIS Committee who voted to recommend approval of the use of GEIS funds for partial funding for the upgrades at the Wastewater Treatment Plant;

now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby authorize award of Contract #1 – General Construction to J. Squared Construction of Voorheesville, NY \$1,062,000.00 for the Wastewater Treatment Plant upgrade project;

and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby approves the use of \$550,000.00 from the Water/Sewer GEIS accounts and \$512,000.00 from Sewer Fund balance to fund the project.

132-2024 A Resolution Authorizing the Town to Award the Contract for the Town Hall Window Replacement Project

WHEREAS, the Town of East Greenbush (the "Town"), sought proposals from qualified construction firms to provide construction-phase services for the replacement of all Town Hall Windows, Framing and screens; and

WHEREAS, the Town was awarded a \$300,000.00 grant to replace the windows at Town Hall and Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Town Hall was constructed in 1922 and has been an operating facility ever since; and

WHEREAS, new windows will make the building more energy efficient and will eliminate the draft coming through the windows in the bitter cold months; and

WHEREAS, the costs for this project will be paid for with the grant money from the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board approved the solicitation of bids for the Town Hall Window Replacement Project in Resolution 286-2023 and bids were received and opened on Friday, May 17, 2024 and reviewed by the DPW Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance confirms that this resolution will not have a material impact on the Town's finances; and

WHEREAS, the recommendation for award is: Shinas Construction Co., LLC for \$290,000.00;

now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of East Greenbush hereby approves the recommendation and award of the above contract as stated above, Shinas Construction Co., LLC of Albany, NY \$290,000.00; and authorizes the Supervisor to sign the contract.
