Ryan M. Phillips, 20 of East Greenbush, was arrested at a town residence after he assaulted a relative who had denied him use of her car. When the victim attempted to call 911, Phillips smashed the phone from her hands and choked her. She was able to run out into the street where a passerby stopped to help. Phillips was taken into custody by Sgt. Michael Condo, arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engel on charges of Assault 2nd Dgr. and numerous other counts, and remanded to County Jail.

In other cases;

Linda M. Abrams, 30 of Cambridge was arrested by Officer Raymond Diaz, after she selected over \$1,000.00 worth of Amazon Fire Tablets, Samsung Tablets and three sets of Beats Headphones electronics and proceeded out of the Target store without stopping at the checkouts to pay for it. She was arraigned before Town Justice Mary Pat Donnelly on charges of Grand Larceny 4th Dgr. and remanded to County Jail.

Xavier I. Prater, 23 of Troy was charged after he left a two year old alone in a parked car for thirty minutes. Officer Michael Herrington responded to the call from concerned Walmart shoppers who noticed the kid there when they entered the store and that he was still there and crying when they came out. Prater was charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Child.
