Vanderlei Nonato Pego, 43 of Brazil was arrested following a traffic stop. Upon interview, Nonato Pego was found to have no license and he was an illegal immigrant from Brazil. He was taken into custody by Detective Michael Guadagnino and then turned over to I.C.E. Agents for deportation.

In other cases;

Jah-Mere Percy Bryant, 19 of Albany was arrested after giving an officer responding to a disturbance at McDonalds a false name. Bryant was charged by Officer Anthony Gullo with False Personation.

Latoya D. Fordham, 35 of Albany was arrested after patrols were dispatched to Target for a shoplifter concealing merchandise while she was supposed to be caring for a minor. Officer Trevor Lagrave arrived and charged Latoya with Grand Larceny 4th, Endangering the Welfare of a Child and Possession of an Anti-Security Device.

Francis U. Fernet, 34 of Cohoes was arrested after he reported to probation in Albany and was found to have an active warrant of arrest stemming from a previous arrest for shoplifting at Walmart. She was charged by Officer Nicholas Peter for Failing to Answer an Appearance Ticket.

Justiana D. Cuebas, 29 of Albany was arrested following an investigation into a stolen credit card. Through investigation, Detective Michael Guadagnino was able to track Justiana down and she was subsequently charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4th.
