Daniel J. Brannock, 30 of East Greenbush, was charged after being found in possession of stolen property. On June 9th, Officer Griffin Hotaling had widely circulated a list of stolen "Magic Card" game collectibles, which had been pilfered overnight from a parked car in town. Pawn shops, second hand dealers and gaming centers were supplied with an itemized list of the stolen property. When the same items showed up days later in Brannock's possession, witnesses contacted police. Officer Mark Herrington responded to investigate and observed Brannock in possession of the stolen property which the officer confiscated, and placed Brannock under arrest. Brannock was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engle charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 3rd Dgr and was remanded to County Jail.

In other cases;

Robert A. Nadeau III, 36 of Albany was arrested by Detective Michael Guadagnino for sneaking into a guest room at a local motel and stealing prescription medications. Nadeau was charged with Burglary 2nd Dgr. and Larceny.

Marc A. Rogers, 51 of Rotterdam was arrested by Detective Michael Guadagnino for Burglary 3rd Dgr. and Larceny, after Rogers was identified as having stolen a 55 inch LG TV, worth \$550.00, from Walmart.

John H. Tobin, 47 of East Greenbush was taken into custody by Detective Michael Guadagnino as a Fugitive From Justice, in connection with a criminal investigation centered in Western Massachusetts.
