Vernon B. Devine, 60 of East Greenbush was charged after he entered the Capital Inn guestroom of a 36 year old town man and stabbed him with a knife in the forearm. Devine fled following the attack and briefly found refuge in another guestroom but was located there by Officer Edward Ashley and taken into custody. Devine was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engel on counts of Assault 1st Dgr., Criminal Possession of a Weapon 4th Dgr. and other charges, and was remanded to County Jail.

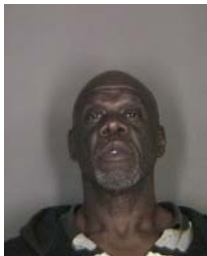
In other cases;

Michael A. Lapins, 31 of North Greenbush was charged by Officer Griffin Hotaling with Larceny for leaving Walmart without paying for two Timex sport watches, worth \$30.00 each.

Kim Y. French, 56 of Albany was charged after she used a "paid for" store brand shopping bag to conceal 2 pairs of shoes, a bed skirt, two curtains and a blanket before leaving the Target store without paying. She was placed under arrest for Larceny by Officer Edward Ashley.

Yolanda N. Gill, 45 and Tiffany R. Seymour, 40, both of Troy, were arrested after they made purchases at Walmart using a stolen credit card. The checkout cashier was alerted by a store-wide notice and police were contacted while the pair were still on store property. They were taken into custody by Detective Michael Guadagnino and Officer Peter Lavin.
