Edward G. Williams, Jr., 23 of Waterford and Sierra M. Kovalsky, 19 of Troy were arrested after police were called about 1:00 a.m. to a street brawl outside a Washington Avenue home.

According to witnesses, the two had arrived by car and proceeded to lure out then attack a 17 year old who resides there. Williams displayed a CO2 pellet pistol during the assault.

The victim was treated for injuries and transported to hospital by Bruen Rescue Squad.

Williams and Kovalsky were charged with Assault 3rd Dgr., Criminal Possession of a Weapon 4th Dgr. and numerous additional counts. They were taken into custody by Officer Edward Ashley assisted by Sgt. Ernest Tubbs and Officer Trevor LaGrave.

Williams and Kovalsky were arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engel and remanded to County Jail pending further court proceedings.

In other cases;

Willie C. Hamilton Jr., 32 of Albany was stopped by Albany Police behind the wheel of car that he had rented but never returned. Town Court had issued a warrant for Hamilton's arrest, after the rental company had made numerous unsuccessful efforts to recover the car and whose return was long overdue. He was arrested by Detective Michael Guadagnino for Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle 3rd Dgr.

Todd C. Ellison, 33 of East Greenbush was charged with Larceny by Officer Warren Kretschmar for consuming Hannaford store merchandise without paying for it.
