Nicholas A. Plue, 30 of Rensselaer was charged with Burglary 2nd Dgr., Unlawful Imprisonment 2nd Dgr. and other charges. Plue was taken into custody by Detective Elaine Rudzinski, for climbing through the bathroom window of the residence of a former acquaintance at 1:00 a.m. and accosting the victim. He was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engel and released on \$50,000.00 bail pending further court proceedings.

In other cases;

Emmanuel S. Booker Jr., 26 of Troy was arrested by Officer Warren Kretzschmar after he tried to remove \$1800.00 worth of I-pads and other Target store merchandise without paying. Booker was charged with counts of Larceny and Grand Larceny.

Isaiah S. Davis, 20 of Troy was one of two perpetrators charged by Officer Griffin Hotaling with stealing over two thousand dollars worth of television merchandise from Walmart. Davis was arraigned before Town Justice Mary Pat Donnelly and remanded to County Jail.

David A. Moore, 58 of Albany was arrested after Walmart employees stopped him from wheeling a \$500.00 Powermate generator out of the store without paying. He was charged with Larceny by Officer Donald Deitz.
