Kimberly Anne Maine, 45 of Niantic Connecticut was arrested by Detective Elaine Rudzinski and Detective Michael Guadagnino resulting from an identify theft investigation. Maine is accused of using checks stolen from a Ballston Lake business and a stolen ID to steal approximately \$4,000.00 from local banks. She was arraigned before Town Justice Mary Pat Donnelly on charges of Identity Theft 1st Dgr., Grand Larceny and Forgery 2nd Dgr. and was remanded to County Jail.

In other cases;

Michael D. Lewis, 43 of Albany was charged with Aggravated Harassment by Officer Mark Herrington, based on the complaint of a town resident that Lewis had contacted him electronically with annoying voice, text or digital content.

Target store security contacted police after they observed Sydney M. Jerome, 20 of Rensselaer take women's shirts and leggings, worth \$100.00, from the merchandise racks and leave the store without paying. She was charged with Larceny by Officer Donald Deitz.

Robert S. Sutliff, 25 and Brandon W. Stanley, 21, both of Nassau were arrested near Walmart where they fled after the pair used pliers to remove a security device from electronics merchandise and bolted from the store with it. Officer Nicholas Peter rounded them up a few hundred yards away and recovered the stolen Xbox hard drive worth \$150.00.
