Jahlil J. Nails, 21 of East Greenbush was arrested July 5th after he took a used vehicle for a test drive and failed to return it to the dealership. He was charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4th Dgr. by Officer Edward Witko. Two days later Nails was re-arrested after relatives observed him handle keys to the family car, apparently intent on taking it. He ran from family members who confronted him, who then called police concerned for his welfare. When stopped and questioned shortly thereafter by Officer Warren Kretzschmar, Nails became belligerent and combative. He was charged in that incident with Obstructing Governmental Administration and Resisting Arrest.

In other cases;

James E. Bass II, 34 of Albany was charged at Walmart, for fraudulently claiming reimbursement for the return of merchandise that he had never purchased. A count of Larceny was lodged by Officer Edward Ashley.

Candace A. Comstock, 29 of East Greenbush was charged when she walked away with lawn and garden supplies, jewelry and clothing merchandise that she had not brought to a checkout. She was arrested for the \$200.00 Larceny by Officer Mark Herrington.

Haddiyah M. Babb, 22 of Albany was charged with shoplifting six cell phone protective cases worth \$75.00. He was charged with Larceny by Officer Edward Witko.
