They were charged with Larceny by Officer Peter Lavin.

In other cases;

Patricia A. Villegas, 55 of Rensselaer was stopped by Walmart employees as she was in the process of pushing a full shopping cart of merchandise out the store without having stopped to pay for it. She was arrested for Larceny by Officer Donald Deitz.

Karim A. Elgaouni, 18 of Latham was charged during a traffic stop with possessing over 27 grams of marijuana. The strong odor of the freshly burned weed signaled the likelihood that the driver might be operating under the influence. Further investigation lead Sgt. Ernest Tubbs to discover the stash.

Jenna A. Kakely, 19 of East Greenbush was charged after she showed up at the home of an acquaintance, knocking on the door to get in. The homeowner would not allow her in, and when Kakely wouldn't leave, the homeowner contacted police. Officer Nicholas Peter arrived to investigate and observed that Kakely was acting in a disoriented manner and after further investigation found her in possession of a quantity of Xanax. She was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance 7th Dgr. and Disorderly Conduct.
