Jonathan M. Downer, 28 of Troy was taken into custody by Officer Griffin Hotaling, after Downer showed up at a former girlfriend's employment in violation of a Court Order of Protection. Downer was arraigned before Town Justice Kevin Engel on charges of Stalking 4th Dgr., Criminal Contempt of Court 2nd Dgr. and other charges, and was remanded to County Jail.

In other cases;

Lyle D. Larose, 41 of Watervliet was arrested by Detective Elaine Rudzinski for using a credit card that had been stolen overnight from a parked car in North Greenbush. LaRose was charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4th Dgr.

Amanda A. Quinones, 22 and Shaynise L. Harden, 23, both of Albany were apprehended as they fled a theft at Walmart. Officer Nicholas Peter spotted the getaway car described by witnesses on Troy Road and took both into custody for Larceny. A TV and other stolen merchandise worth over \$600.00 was recovered from the car.

Harresa J. Moore, 23 of Troy was charged by Officer Edward Ashley with Burglary 3rd Dgr. and Larceny for taking off with over \$200.00 in store merchandise without paying. Moore had previously been banned from entering any Walmart based on prior shopliftings. She was turned over to Guilderland Police who held an unrelated warrant for her arrest.
