Ryan T. O'Connor, 33 of Clifton Park was charged by Detective Sgt. Elaine Rudzinski following the investigation into a sexual abuse complaint. O'Connor was arraigned before Town Justice George J. Hoffman Jr. on counts of Sexual Abuse 1st Dgr. and Endangering the Welfare of a Child and placed on electronic monitoring pending further court proceedings.

In other cases;

Gurvinder S. Kundal, 46 of Albany was charged with the offense of Forcible Touching based on the complaint of a 32 year old victim acquaintance. He was taken into custody by Detective Sgt. Elaine Rudzinski.

James B. Freehill III, 41 of East Greenbush was arrested in connection with the Burglary of a neighbors residence, where cash and checks were stolen. He was charged with Burglary 2nd Dgr. and Larceny by Detective Sgt. Elaine Rudzinski.

James J. Smith, 46 of Troy was arrested for stealing socks, pants, men's boots, juice, kids underwear and pizza. He was charged with Larceny following an investigation at Walmart by Detective Michael Guadagnino.
