Jason Bates, 38 of Galway was charged by Officer Mark Herrington with the \$215 dollar Larceny of shaving supplies and fish tank equipment from Walmart.

In other cases;

Yashina L. Miller, 43 of Cohoes was arrested by Officer Mark Herrington for starting a fight at Denny's that resulted in broken furniture and unlawful physical battery to patrons and staff. She was charged with Criminal Mischief-Damage to Property, Harassment and Disorderly Conduct.

Nathan J. Desharnais, 32 of Plattsburgh was arrested after he fled the Target store with two stolen laptop tablets worth \$325.00. The getaway car description was broadcast by Town Police dispatchers and was quickly spotted by Sgt. Michael Condo on Troy Road. A traffic stop was conducted and Desharnais was taken into custody. He was charged with Larceny and for Possession of Heroin and Hypodermic needles and remanded to County Jail by Town Justice Mary Pat Donnelly.

Curtis L. Tunstall, 35 of Troy dodged the Walmart check-outs with a shopping cart full of toys and loaded them into a waiting Ford pickup truck outside. The truck sped away onto Troy Road, where Officer Griffin Hotaling observed it and conducted a traffic stop near FedEx. Turnstall was charged with Burglary and Larceny, and was remanded to County Jail. The getaway-truck driver, William R. Burns, 51 of Ticonderoga was charged with Conspiracy 5th Dgr.
