Jennifer Demarest, 30 of Albany was arrested following a traffic stop for not having a front plate. Upon investigation it was revealed Jennifer had a suspended driver's license and a warrant for her arrest out of Albany. During an inventory search of the vehicle two glass pipes with cocaine residue were found. Jennifer was charged by Detective Michael Guadagnino for Aggravated Unlicensed Operator 2<sup>nd</sup> and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7<sup>th</sup>. She was then turned over to Albany Police Department.

In other cases;

Shawn Douglas, 47 of Albany turned himself in after he was advised of charges against him for failing to pay for gas then driving away. He was charged with Petit Larceny by Officer Edward Ashley.

Jalil Fulton, 24 of Troy was arrested after he was stealing merchandise from Walmart. Jalil was also found to be in possession of marihuana and cocaine. He was charged with Petit Larceny, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substnace 4th and Unlawful Possession of Marihuana by Officer Anthony Gullo. He was remanded to Rensselaer County Jail.

Salvatore Graziano, 49 of East Greenbush was arrested after he cashed a check for the victims tax returns that he claimed to file but never did. He was charged with Petit Larceny by Detective Guadagnino.

Curtis Williams Jr, 51 of Fairmont Vermont was arrested following an investigation of a stolen firearm at a local hotel. Through investigation Curtis was found to be in possession of a loaded Glock 22 which he could not possess being a convicted felon and having no NYS permit. He was charged with Criminal Possession of a Firearm and Criminal Possession of a Weapon 2<sup>nd</sup> by Officer Griffin Hotaling.
