Joseph P. Lacasse, 40 of East Greenbush was arrested at the scene of a domestic dispute called in by neighbors. Despite there being an Order of Protection in place for the other party, Lacasse nevertheless quarreled with her and at one point wrapped his arms around her throat, choking her. He was taken into custody by Officer Peter Lavin and charged with Criminal Contempt 2nd Dgr., Obstructing Breathing and other counts.

In other cases;

Ronald A. Collins Jr., 24 of East Greenbush was charged after getting into a temper tantrum with his mother where he kicked holes in the walls of the apartment that they share. He also took his mothers phone away when she went for it to call for help. Friends learned what was happening anyway and called police. Collins was arrested by Officer Raymond Diaz for Criminal Mischief/Damage to Property and with Criminal Preventing an Emergency Call. Collins was arraigned before Town Justice Mary Pat Donnelly and remanded to County Jail.

Target store workers saw someone walk out of the store without paying for merchandise she was carrying. Officer Edward Witko responded and arrested Teearra N. Monroe, 19 of Albany. She was charged with the Larceny of a cell phone case and a pair of socks.
