Stephen M. Rakowski, 60, of Saratoga Springs was arrested after he contacted the telephone receptionist of a commercial enterprise located in East Greenbush and voiced his intention to go there and engage in a mass shooting of employees. He was taken into custody in Saratoga Springs late yesterday by Detective Sgt. Elaine Rudzinski and Detective Michael Guadagnino and charged with Making a Terroristic Threat. Rakowski was arraigned before Town Justice Mary Pat Donnelly and remanded to County Jail.

In other cases;

Shannon R. Taylor, 35 of East Greenbush was charged following an altercation at a private residence which resulted in personal injury. She was taken into custody by Officer Michael Herrington on a charge of Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> Dgr. and Criminal Mischief/Damage to Property.

Frank H. Rivers, Jr., 36 and William J. Morehouse, 24, both of Sand Lake, were seen loading a shopping cart with a variety of Walmart merchandise, when they abruptly pushed the cart out of the store without paying. Store security saw them load the stolen property into a vehicle and take off. Security contacted town police dispatchers who broadcast an all-points BOLO. Shortly thereafter, North Greenbush Police officers spotted the vehicle and took the pair into custody. Both were charged with the \$550.00 Larceny.
